

Chapter 295 – FIBROMYALGIA AND CHRONIC FATIGUE SYNDROME

Fibromyalgia (FM) and chronic **fatigue** syndrome (CFS) are multisymptomatic syndromes defined respectively by the core features of chronic widespread pain and chronic unexplained **fatigue**. The 1990 American College of Rheumatology classification criteria for FM are universally used in diagnosing FM ([Table 295-1](#)). The 1994 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) definition is the most widely used diagnostic criteria for CFS (see [Table 295-1](#)). According to these definitions, FM and CFS are separate entities, but in practice there is a large overlap, with many patients being given both labels. Myofascial pain is a universal experience that is usually self-limited; when it becomes persistent, it may accentuate and perpetuate the experience of chronic **fatigue** and FM.



- Try the ***Clinical Queries*** feature in the left menu to search by clinical study category
- Use **[tiab]** to find a word or "phrase" in the title or abstract of an article.
Ex: "heart murmur"[tiab]
- Use  **UC-eLinks** to the right of an abstract to get to full-text articles
- Use the **Copy & Paste Citation** link in *UC-eLinks* to generate the article's citation
